In the interest of helping our businesses to be competitive, meet the needs of their customers and offer more choices, I am writing to request support for the People's Gas Program, the Firm Transportation Aggregation Rider 2 through May 31, 2001.

People's Gas filed a petition in July requesting further expansion of the experimental program to offer transportation service to those customers who purchase gas packages on their own. Currently gas marketers have the ability to create attractive gas packages for customers, whereas People's Gas, as a regulated entity, has considerably less flexibility. Allowing People's Gas to enter into this competitive market in a thoughtful, methodical way would allow them to offer additional choices for their customers, keep prices low, and increase utilization of their fixed assets.
