An unedited version of the information contained in Attachment "A" was submitted to the Division of Records and Reporting on October 15, 1999, together with Omnipoint's Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification for this document and is provided herewith under a separate cover marked "confidential" with the information asserted to be confidential highlighted in yellow.

2. The attached document contains existing and projected NXX Code utilization information for Omnipoint's operations in Florida, including, for each NXX code, data reflecting the: (a) the number of available 1,000 blocks with less than 10% contamination; (b) number of aging numbers; (c) number of telephone numbers available for reassignment; (d) number of reserved

telephone numbers; and (e) number of assigned and active telephone numbers for each 1,000 block. Omnipoint's current and projected utilization of NXX codes and the related NXX code utilization data described above is "proprietary confidential business information" as contemplated by Section 364.183(3), Florida Statutes (1997), because such information is intended to be and is treated by Omnipoint as highly sensitive, private and confidential information and the public disclosure of such information would cause harm to Omnipoint's competitive interests and business operations by enabling Omnipoint's competitors to analyze such information and gain knowledge concerning Omnipoint's market share and marketing strategies.

WHEREFORE, Omnipoint respectfully requests that the Commission issue an order declaring that the information reflected in the document attached hereto as Attachment "A" is proprietary confidential business information and exempt from disclosure under the public records laws of the State of Florida.
