CASE BACKGROUND

On November 6, 1998, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. (BellSouth) and Sprint-Florida, Inc. (Sprint) filed a joint petition (ATTACHMENT A) to modify four exchange boundaries located in Orange and Hernando counties. These boundary changes would place the areas in question wholly within one exchange, but would move certain areas from one LEC's territory to the other's territory. For the purpose of this recommendation, an exchange boundary change is the same as a transfer of territory.

On January 14 and 15, 1999, staff conducted on-site visits to the four areas listed in the joint petition. Sprint and BellSouth representatives were present at the visits. Contrary to what was stated in the petition, staff discovered during the on-site visits that there were customers being served and facilities in place. It appeared that BellSouth's and Sprint's regulatory staff were

unaware of this until the on-site visits. From all indications, the present subscribers were unaware of BellSouth's and Sprint's pending transfer of territory.

At the March 30, 1999, Agenda Conference, the initial joint petition in Docket No. 981571-TL was deferred at the request of BellSouth and Sprint. Staff had recommended that the joint petition be denied because it did not meet the requirements of Rules 25-4.005(1)(a), (b), and (c) and 25-4.005(3), Florida Administrative Code, Transfer of Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity as to All or a Portion of Service Areas. Staff recommended that BellSouth and Sprint be required to submit a complete and accurately documented petition.

On July 23, 1999, BellSouth and Sprint filed, simultaneously, a Notice of Withdrawal of the Joint Petition filed on November 6, 1998, in Docket No. 981571-TL (ATTACHMENT B), and a new joint petition (Docket No. 990958-TL) to modify certain exchange boundaries in Orange and Hernando counties and to amend the companies' certificates, accordingly. (ATTACHMENT C)

Included with the joint petition, BellSouth and Sprint also filed an Affidavit (EXHIBIT E) with verification of compliance with Rules 25-4.005(1)(a), (b), and (c) and 25-4.005(3), Florida Administrative Code.

This is staff's recommendation on the joint petition.

ISSUE 1: Should the joint petition filed by BellSouth and Sprint to modify certain exchange boundaries in Orange and Hernando counties and amend the companies' certificates be approved?

RECOMMENDATION: Yes. The joint petition filed by BellSouth and Sprint should be approved because it meets the requirements of Rules 25-4.005(1)(a), (b), and (c) and 25-4.005(3), Florida Administrative Code, Transfer of Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity as to All or a Portion of Service Areas. In addition, Bellsouth and Sprint should file tariffs within sixty days of the issuance date of the order reflecting the exchange boundary changes. (HAWKINS, C. LEWIS)

STAFF ANALYSIS: On July 23, 1999, BellSouth and Sprint filed a joint petition for the transfer of certain areas in Orange and Hernando counties and to amend the companies' certificates.

The first proposed boundary change is to move a portion of the Riverfront Apartment Complex located in Orlando, Florida, and a portion of the Econ River Estates subdivision, also located in Orlando, from the Sprint Winter Park Exchange to the BellSouth Orlando-Azalea Park Exchange. The Riverfront Apartment Complex is an established community within the BellSouth Orlando-Azalea Park Exchange. The northern portion of the Riverfront Apartment Complex is located in the Sprint Winter Park Exchange. The petition states that the boundary change for the Riverfront Apartment Complex is being made to include a very small portion of common area and parking lot where no customers reside or will ever likely reside. After reviewing the proposed joint petition, staff concludes that no subscribers would be affected by modifying the BellSouth Orlando-Azalea Park Exchange to include all of the Riverfront Apartment Complex. (EXHIBIT A)

The Econ River Estates is an established community. Thirty-three of the 91 residential lots in the Econ River Estates Subdivision are located in the BellSouth Orlando-Azalea Park Exchange and the remainder are in the Sprint Winter Park Exchange. Staff notes that BellSouth is currently providing service to the 58 subscribers located in the Sprint Winter Park Exchange. Since all Econ River Estates' residents are presently paying BellSouth rates, staff believes that customers would be unaffected, in practice, by including the entire Econ River Estates subdivision.

The second proposed boundary change is to move part of the Plateau Subdivision from BellSouth's Brooksville exchange to Sprint's Trilacoochee exchange. Currently 13 of the 52 residential lots are located in the Brooksville exchange, with the remainder located in the Trilacoochee exchange. All lots are presently owned by the developer. Staff agrees that no subscribers would be affected by modifying the Sprint Trilacoochee Exchange to include the entire Plateau Subdivision because no houses have been built yet. (EXHIBIT B)

The third proposed boundary change is to move part of the proposed Windermere Chase Subdivision located in BellSouth's Orlando exchange to Sprint's Winter Garden exchange. On its visit, staff found that Windermere Chase is a subdivision with over 20 lots in BellSouth's territory. The developed part (Phase 1) of Windermere is located in BellSouth's territory with no homes under construction at the time of staff's site visit. Therefore, staff confirms that no homes have yet been built in the area to be transferred. (EXHIBIT C)

The fourth proposed boundary change is to move part of the Westminister Reserve Subdivision located in Sprint's Windermere exchange to BellSouth's Orlando exchange. The petition states that the majority of the residential lots in the subdivision are located in the BellSouth Orlando-Pine Hills Exchange. Staff agrees that there are only nine houses located in the Sprint Windermere Exchange. Since BellSouth is presently providing service to these nine homes, staff believes that customers would be unaffected, in practice, by this boundary change. (EXHIBIT D)

Staff agrees with BellSouth's and Sprint's statements in their petition that present boundary lines are generally along section lines, roads and streets. In some cases, the existing boundary bisects planned subdivisions located in both companies' territories. In addition, boundaries may bisect individual lots in planned subdivisions, which makes servicing difficult. Through this petition the companies are requesting to transfer territory in order to avoid dividing planned subdivisions and to move the existing boundary to more readily discernable terrain features. Boundary redefinitions will minimize, if not negate, the future possibility that boundaries in these areas could bisect subdivisions or individual lots, thereby rendering the boundaries more usable in the provision and administration of service.

Staff concludes that BellSouth and Sprint have complied with applicable provisions of Rules 25-4.005(1)(a), (b), (c) and 25-4.003(3), Florida Administrative Code, which state that:

(1) Request for approval by the Commission of the transfer of any certificate of public convenience and necessity (or portion thereof) shall be made by joint petition of the certificate holder and transferee after reasonable notice has been given to all subscribers affected by the proposed transfer. Requests for approval shall be accompanied by an affidavit that notice of intention to file the petition has been given: (a) By mail or personal delivery to the governing bodies of the counties and municipalities affected, to the Public Counsel, and to the Commission, (b) By a legal advertisement in a newspaper of general circulation in the area affected and published on two (2) separate occasions at least two (2) weeks prior to the filing of the joint petition on the proposed transfer, and (c) By written notice subject to Commission approval, issued to each subscriber in the area to be transferred concurrent with the filing of the petition. . . .

(3) Such joint petitions shall include detailed descriptions of the affected boundaries; the number of subscribers, if any, in each petitioned area; changes in rates; service being provided by either petitioner in areas to be transferred; pending applications for service held by either petitioner; changes in calling scope; customers to be transferred; deposits and deposit interest; any financial exchange or consideration for the proposed change, and a list by name and telephone number of all customers who will be exempt from the proposed change.

Since this boundary change request eliminates cross boundary service and does not adversely affect customers, staff recommends that BellSouth's and Sprint's proposed request to modify certain exchange boundaries in Orange and Hernando counties be approved. In addition, BellSouth and Sprint should file tariffs within sixty days of the issuance date of the order reflecting the exchange boundary changes.

**JOINT PETITION OF BELLSOUTH TELECOMMUNICATIONS, INC.

TO MODIFY CERTAIN EXCHANGE BOUNDARIES**

BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth") and Sprint-Florida, Inc. ("Sprint"), pursuant to Rule 25-22.036, Florida Administrative Code, petitions the Florida Public Service Commission (the "Commission") to modify certain exchange boundaries. As grounds in support of this joint petition, BellSouth and Sprint state as follows:

1. BellSouth is a telephone company lawfully doing business in the State of Florida, the regulated operations of which are subject to the Commission pursuant to Chapter 364, Fla. Stat.
2. Sprint is a telephone company lawfully doing business in the State of Florida, the regulated operations of which are subject to the Commission pursuant to Chapter 364, Fla. Stat.
3. BellSouth's principal place of business in Florida is 150 W. Flagler Street, Suite 1910, Miami, Florida 33130.
4. Sprint's principal place of business in Florida is 555 Lake Border Drive, Apopka, Florida 32713.

6. BellSouth and Sprint seek four exchange boundary changes in this petition. The first boundary change is to move the proposed Riverfront Apartment Complex to be located in Orlando, Florida, and the proposed Econ River Estates Subdivision to be located in Orlando, Florida, from the Sprint-Florida Goldenrod Exchange to the BellSouth Orlando-Azalea Park Exchange. Copies of the current exchange service area maps for these two exchanges are attached as Exhibit A. Copies of the proposed service area maps are attached as Exhibit B.

7. Approximately 90 percent of the Riverfront Apartment Complex is currently within the BellSouth Orlando-Azalea Park Exchange. No subscribers would be affected by modifying the Orlando-Azalea Park Exchange to include the Riverfront Apartment Complex because the complex has not yet been built.

8. Thirty-six of the 91 residential lots in the Econ River Estates Subdivision are located in the BellSouth Orlando-Azalea Park Exchange. The remainder of the subdivision is in the Sprint-Florida Goldenrod Exchange. No subscribers would be

affected by modifying the Orlando-Azalea Park Exchange to include the entire Econ River Estates subdivision because no houses have yet been built. L

9. The second boundary change is to move part of the proposed Plateau subdivision to be located in Trilacoochee, Florida, from the BellSouth Brooksville Exchange to the Sprint Trilacoochee Exchange. Thirteen of the 52 residential lots are located in the Brooksville Exchange; the remainder are in the Trilacoochee Exchange. No subscribers would be affected by modifying the Trilacoochee Exchange to include the entire Plateau Subdivision because no houses have been built yet. Copies of the current exchange service area maps for these two exchanges are attached as Exhibit C. Copies of the proposed service area maps are attached as Exhibit D.

10. The third boundary change is to move part of the proposed Windermere Chase Subdivision to be located in Winter Garden, Florida, from the BellSouth Orlando-Pine Hills Exchange to the Sprint Winter Garden Exchange. The majority of the residential lots are located in the Winter Garden Exchange. No subscribers would be affected by modifying the Winter Garden Exchange to include the entire Windermere Chase Subdivision because no houses have yet been built. Copies of the current exchange service area maps for these two exchanges are attached as Exhibit E. Copies of the proposed service area maps are attached as Exhibit F.

11. The fourth boundary change is to move part of the proposed Westminster Reserve Subdivision to be located in Orlando, Florida, from the Sprint Windermere exchange to the BellSouth Orlando - Pine Hills exchange. The majority of the residential lots are located in the Orlando - Pine Hills exchange. No subscribers would be affected by modifying the Orlando - Pine Hills exchange to include the entire


Westminster Reserve Subdivision because no houses have yet been built. Copies of the current exchange service area maps for these two exchanges are attached as Exhibit G. Copies of the proposed service area maps are attached as Exhibit H.

12. Upon the Commission's approval of the modifications proposed herein, the parties will file the final tariff sheets for administrative approval.

WHEREFORE, BellSouth and Sprint respectfully request the Commission to modify the exchange boundaries listed herein as proposed.



BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth") and Sprint-Florida, Incorporated ("Sprint"), pursuant to Rules 25-4.005 and 28.106.201, Florida Administrative Code, jointly petition the Florida Public Service Commission (the "Commission" or "FPSC") to modify certain exchange boundaries in Orange and Hernando Counties and to amend the companies' certificates accordingly. In support of this petition, BellSouth and Sprint state as follows:

1. BellSouth is a telephone company lawfully doing business in the State of Florida, the regulated operations of which are subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission pursuant to Chapter 364, Fla. Stat. BellSouth provides service in Florida under FPSC Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 8.
2. Sprint is a telephone company lawfully doing business in the State of Florida, the regulated operations of which are subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission pursuant to Chapter 364, Fla. Stat.

Sprint provides service in Florida under FPSC Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 22.

3. BellSouth's principal place of business in Florida is 150 W. Flagler Street, Suite 1910, Miami, Florida 33130.
4. Sprint's principal place of business in Florida is 555 Lake Border Drive, Apopka, Florida 32713.

6. BellSouth and Sprint seek four exchange boundary changes in this petition. The first boundary change is to move a portion of the proposed Riverfront Apartment Complex, located in Orlando, Florida, and a portion of the proposed Econ River Estates Subdivision, located in Orlando, Florida, from the Sprint Winter Park Exchange to the BellSouth Orlando-Azalea Park Exchange. Copies of the proposed service area maps are attached as Exhibit A.

7. The Riverfront Apartment Complex is an established community within the BellSouth Orlando-Azalea Park Exchange. The northern portion of the Riverfront Apartment Complex is located in the Sprint Winter Park Exchange. No subscribers would be affected by modifying the BellSouth Orlando-Azalea Park Exchange to include all of the Riverfront Apartment Complex.¹
8. Thirty-three of the 91 residential lots in the Econ River Estates Subdivision are located in the BellSouth Orlando-Azalea Park Exchange; the remainder are in the Sprint Winter Park Exchange. The Econ River Estates is an established community. Currently BellSouth, with Sprint's acquiescence, is providing service to fifty-eight subscribers located in the Sprint Winter Park Exchange. Fifty-eight subscribers would be only nominally affected by modifying the BellSouth Orlando-Azalea Park Exchange to include the entire Econ River Estates subdivision since their service is currently provided by BellSouth.
9. The second boundary change is to move part of the proposed Plateau subdivision into the Sprint Trilacoochee Exchange. Thirteen of the 52 residential lots are located in the BellSouth Brooksville Exchange; the remainder are in the Sprint Trilacoochee

¹ As shown in the attached map as Exhibit A, the Riverfront boundary change for the Riverfront Apartment Complex is merely to include a very small portion of common area and parking lot where no customers reside (or will likely ever reside). BellSouth and Sprint did not include this area in the notices since it could not have any conceivable customer impact, would have confused Riverfront residents and is not required to be noticed under the rule.

Exchange. No subscribers would be affected by modifying the Sprint Trilacoochee Exchange to include the entire Plateau Subdivision because no houses have been built yet. Copies of the proposed service area maps are attached as Exhibit B.

10. The third boundary change is to move part of the proposed Windermere Chase Subdivision to be located in Winter Garden, Florida, from the BellSouth Orlando-Pine Hills Exchange to the Sprint Winter Garden Exchange. No subscribers would be affected by modifying the Winter Garden Exchange to include the entire Windermere Chase Subdivision because no houses have yet been built. A Copy of the proposed service area map is attached as Exhibit C.
11. The fourth boundary change is to move part of the proposed Westminster Reserve Subdivision into the BellSouth Orlando-Pine Hills Exchange. The majority of the residential lots in the subdivision are located in the BellSouth Orlando-Pine Hills Exchange. This subdivision is an established subdivision with only nine houses located in the Sprint Windermere Exchange. Currently BellSouth, with Sprint's acquiescence, is providing service to the nine houses located in the Sprint Windermere Exchange. Nine subscribers would be only nominally affected by modifying the BellSouth Orlando-Pine Hills Exchange to include the entire

Westminster Reserve Subdivision since their service is currently provided by BellSouth. A Copy of the proposed service area map is attached as Exhibit D.

12. Upon the Commission's approval of the modifications proposed herein, the parties will file the final tariff sheets for administrative approval.
13. No financial exchange or consideration was, or shall be, given for this proposed transfer of Certificated Areas. This Joint Application is the only written agreement between the applicants.
14. The present boundary lines are generally along section lines, and roads and streets. In some cases, the existing boundary bisects planned subdivisions located in both companies' territories. In addition, the present boundaries may bisect individual lots in planned subdivisions, rendering provision of service difficult. This application is sought to permit revision in company boundaries, which will not divide planned subdivisions, and to move the existing boundary to more readily discernible terrain features. It is intended that the boundary line redefinitions will minimize, if not negate, the future possibility that boundaries in these areas could bisect subdivisions or individual lots, thereby rendering the boundaries more usable in the provision and administration of service.

15. Both BellSouth and Sprint have agreed that the requested transfer of service area is feasible from an economic standpoint and beneficial to the subscribers of both companies.
16. Pursuant to FPSC Rule 25-4.005, the required affidavits are attached to this Joint Petition as Exhibit "E", and certify that notice of intention to file the Petition has been given to those parties set forth in the above cited rule.

WHEREFORE, Sprint and BellSouth request that this Joint Petition be considered, and that the FPSC redefine the boundaries of the Petitioners' Certificates of Public convenience and Necessity as requested in the Petition, and that the FPSC enter an appropriate order to effectuate such a redefinition.



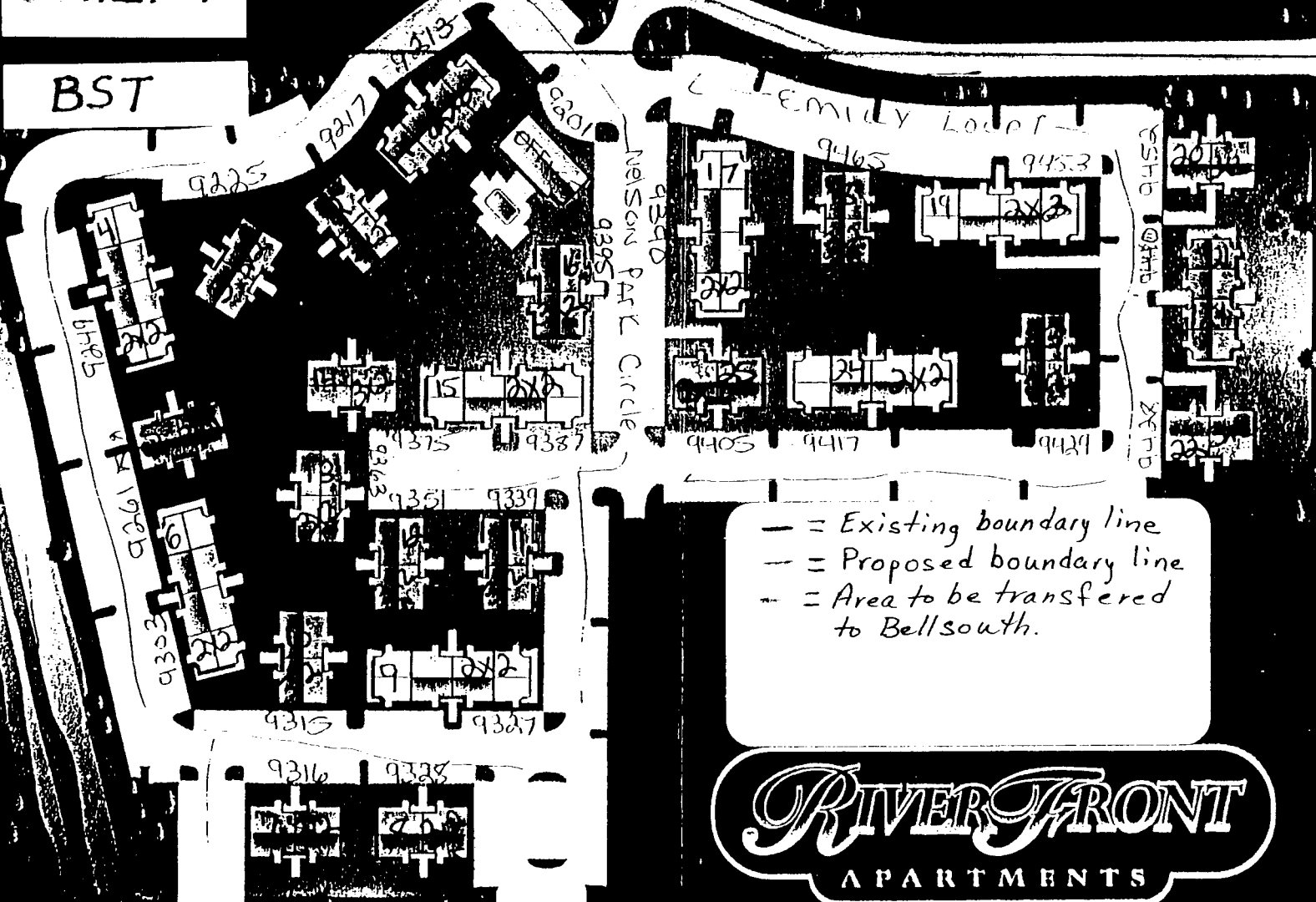

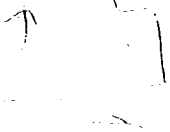

(NOT TO SCALE)

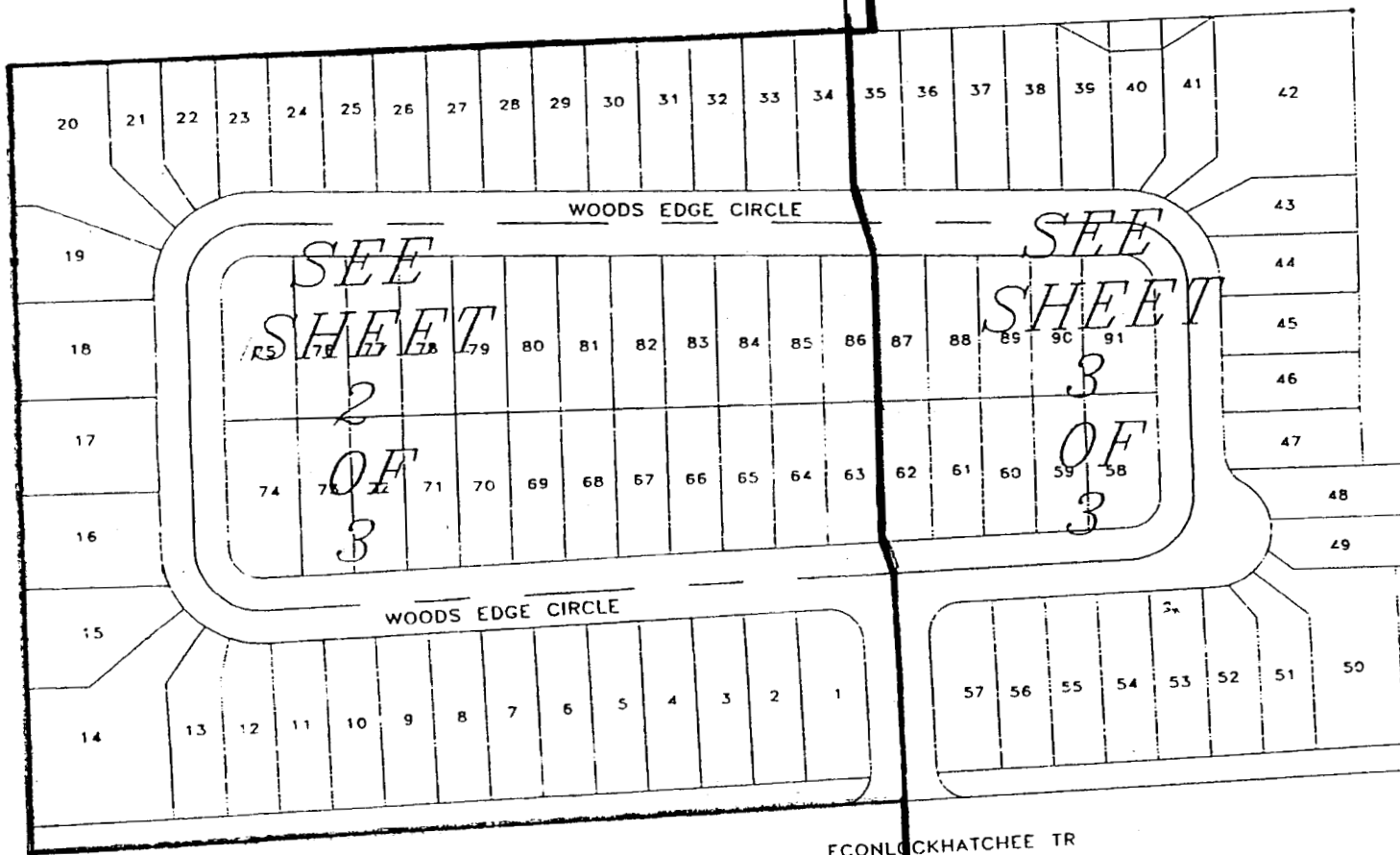

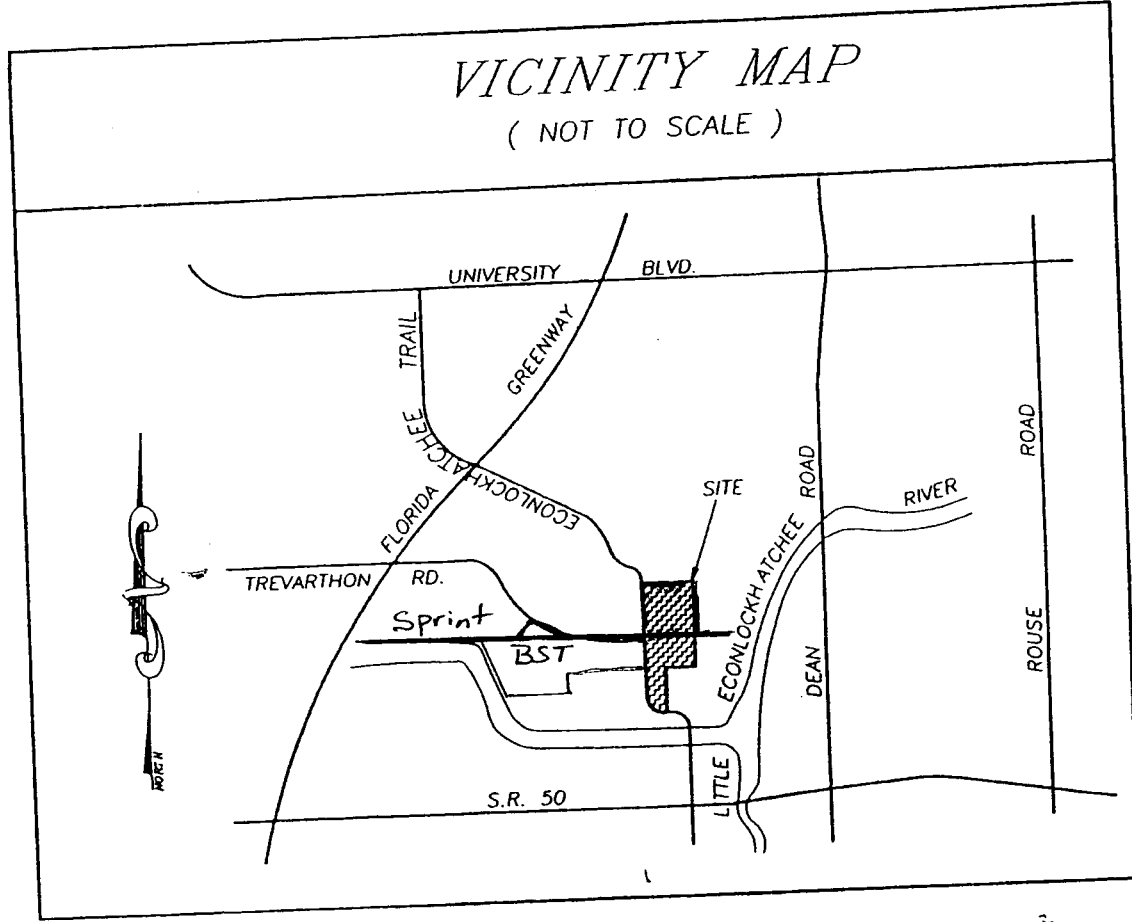


ARBOR RIDGE - UNIT 6

ECON RIVER ESTATES

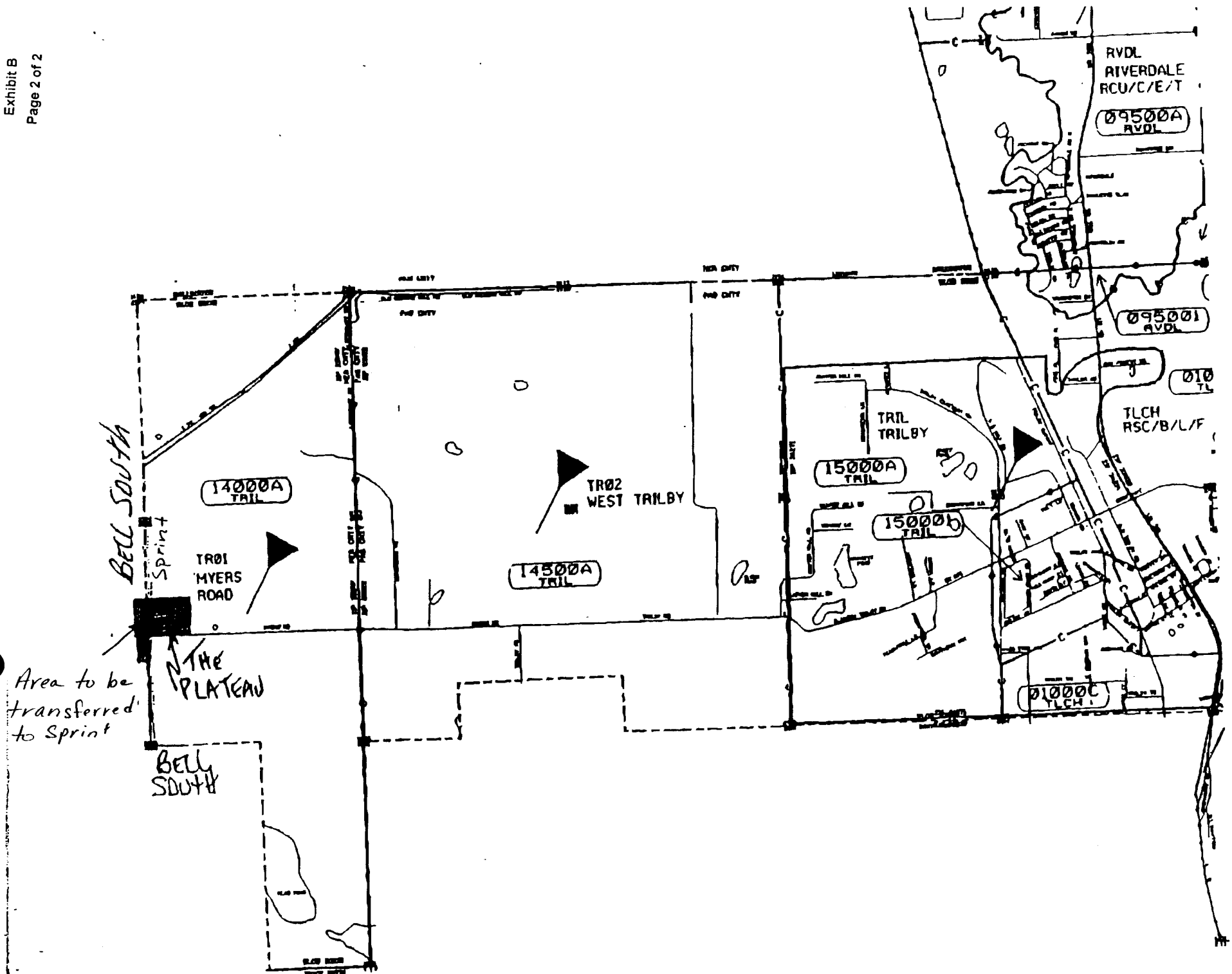

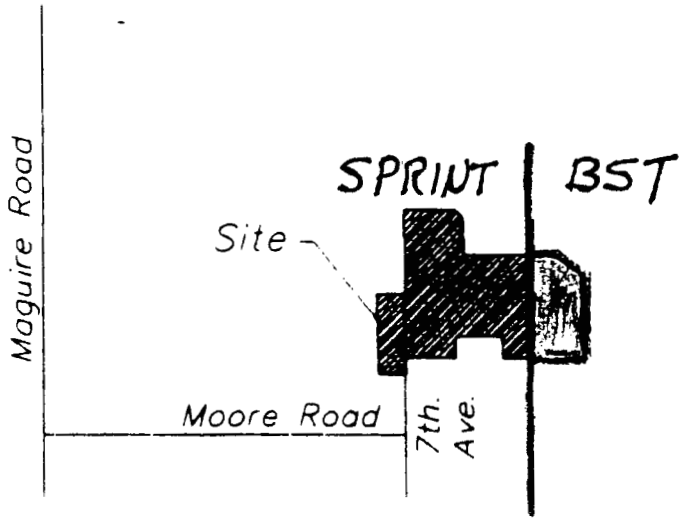

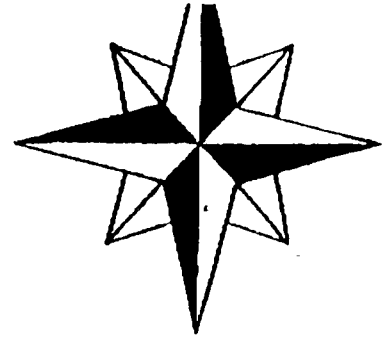

Location Map

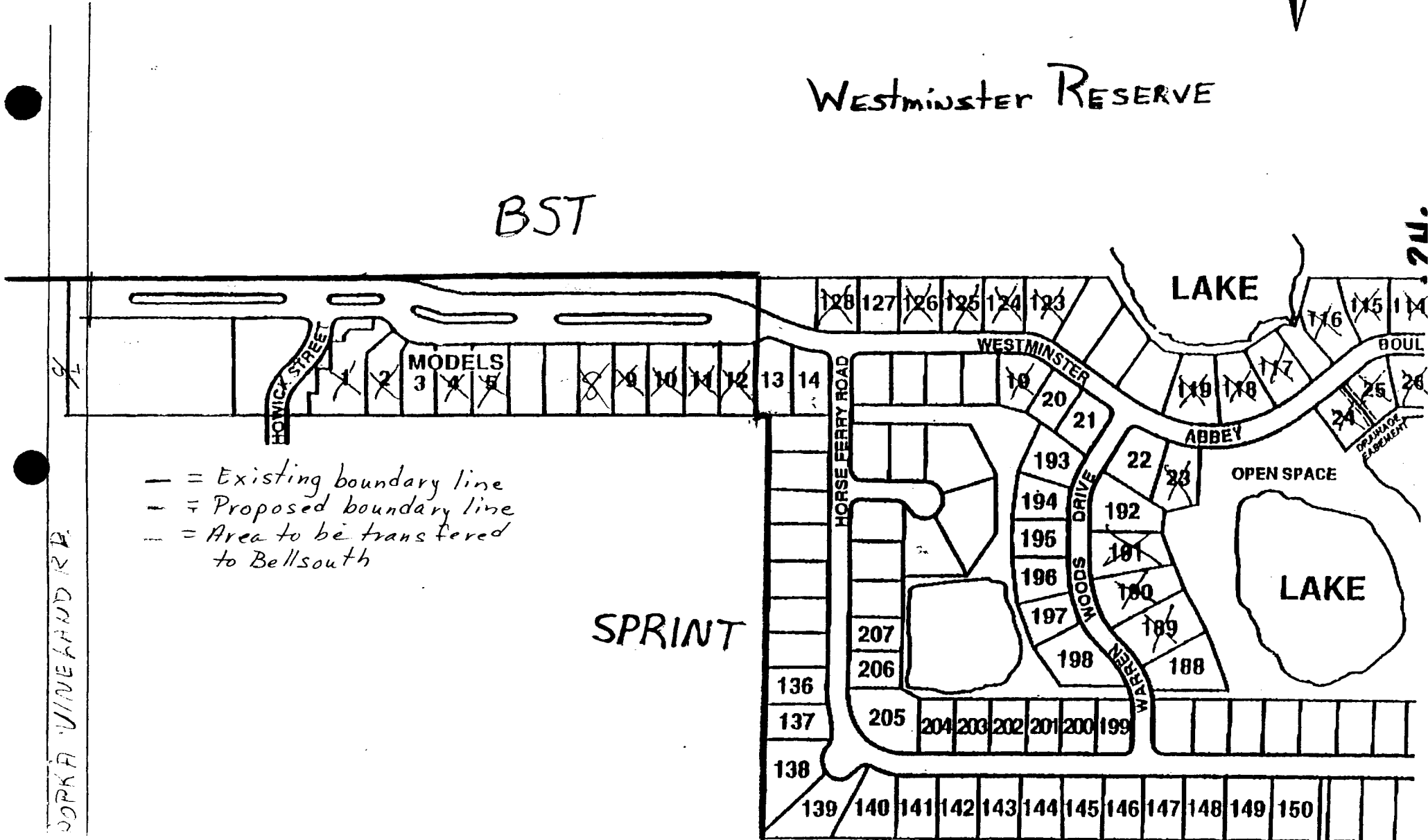
