NOTICE OF FILING

COMES NOW, MediaOne Florida Telecommunications, Inc, ("MediaOne") by and through its undersigned counsel and hereby files with the Florida Public Service Commission this Notice of Filing.

On October 14, 1999, the Florida Public Service Commission ("FPSC") filed its Final Order on Arbitration, Order No. PSC-99-2009-FOF-TP. On October 29, 1999, MediaOne filed its Motion for Reconsideration and Request to File Supplemental Authority. In that motion MediaOne advised the FPSC that on September 15, 1999, the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") decided the UNE Remand Proceeding. At the direction of the United States Supreme Court, the FCC there reconsidered section 51.319 of its rules, which established conclusively the network elements to be offered on an unbundled basis by the incumbent local exchange carrier. MediaOne believes that the findings of the FCC in the UNE Remand Proceeding are dispositive of the issues raised by Media One in this proceeding concerning the Calling Name Database and the appropriate treatment of Network Terminating Wire ("NTW").

FPSC-RECORDS/REPORTING

At the time of MediaOne's Motion for Reconsideration, the FCC had not released its written order in the UNE Remand Proceeding. It had only issued a press release summarizing its decisions. In its Motion for Reconsideration MediaOne sought permission to file supplemental authority in the form of the FCC's final written order once that order was available.

On November 5, 1999, the FCC issued its Third Report and Order and Fourth Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking in the UNE Remand Proceeding.¹ The written report exceeds 500 pages in length and the undersigned believes that this Commission is already in possession of a copy of that Order. Consequently, a copy of the written order is not attached with this Notice of Filing.

WHEREFORE, MediaOne hereby respectfully requests that this Commission consider the findings contained in the UNE Remand Proceeding and grant MediaOne's Motion for Reconsideration.


