This is a follow up to our telephone conversation concerning the above docket. I checked our records and found that your 1998 payment of \$50 was postmarked November 9, 1999. However, the statutory penalty and interest charges were not paid. This means you still owe \$17.50 (\$12.50 penalty and \$5.00 interest). When you send in your check, please indicate that the \$17.50 is for the 1998 penalty and interest. I have enclosed the 1999 form as you requested. The 1999 fee is not due until January 31, 2000.

In addition to paying the past due penalty and interest, if the company wants to keep the certificate active, it must make a settlement offer. In other, similar cases, the Commission has accepted a \$100 settlement in lieu of the \$500 fine normally imposed for this rule violation. The settlement letter needs to include the docket number, state that it has taken steps to prevent this rule violation from happening in the future, make a specific monetary settlement, and state that the past due amount has since been paid (after you have done so, of course). Any settlement offer should be addressed to Ms. Blanca Bayó, Director, Division of Records and Reporting, Florida Public Service Commission, at the above address. As information, the proposed settlement amount should not be paid at this time. It will become due after the Commissioners vote on this issue.

As required by Order No. PSC-99-2416-PAA-TC, you must respond to the Order by December 29, 1999 so that your Certificate No. 5543 will remain active and in good standing with the FPSC.

I hope this has been responsive to your call. If you have any other questions, please let me know.
