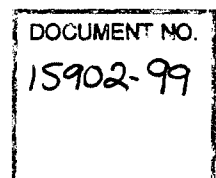





This letter is to protest the proposed rate increase by United Water Florida, Inc. being considered by the Florida Public Service Commission.

In June, 1997, customers of United Water (more than 28,000 consumers in Duval, St. Johns, and Nassau counties) were subjected to a 23% increase in water/wastewater utility rates.

If this new proposed increase is approved by the PSC, United Water's rate would be 35% higher than Jacksonville Electric Authority's rate in same/similar areas.

United Water claims the increase is necessary to make corrections and upgrades in water quality and service. Such "improvements" have not been seen since the last rate increase. Customers have complaints about: taste, odor, color, and sediment in the water; damage to pipes, plumbing fixtures, and water heaters; and low water pressure.

On this city block alone, there are 7 households with widows living on fixed incomes, as well as families with 2-3 children; both groups will be strapped to keep up with proposed increases of such amounts and frequency. We have no alternative for service.

Please deny the proposed increase at November 23rd's meeting.
