Thank you for your February 8, 1999 e-mail regarding the proposed relief plans for the 941 area code. We truly appreciate your interest and concern. Your e-mail will be placed in the correspondece file for Docket No. 990184-TP.

As you may be aware, the Florida Public Service Commission (FPSC) held informational workshops in Ft. Myers at 10 am on December 9, 1998, in Naples at 10 am and 6 pm on December 17, 1998, in Bartow at 10 am on January 27, 1999, and in Sarasota at 1 pm on February 5, 1999, to receive input from customers regarding the relief proposals for the 941 area code. There have been protests to the proposed 941 area code relief, and therefore, the FPSC opened Docket No. 990223 to address issues and get input from customers who were unable to attend the earlier workshops. The FPSC also opened Docket No. 990184-TL to address issues related to the Englewood boundary exchange issues.

The FPSC scheduled public hearings in Sarasota County and Lee County. The dates, times, and locations are shown below.



It is our understanding that a change of area codes is being considered for our area. We write to strongly protest such a move.

I, Annabelle Weir, live in East Englewood. I am a senior citizen (will be 80 years old) and such a change would adversely effect me seriously. I do volunteer work weekly at the Englewood Hospital and at a nursing home in Englewood. I also attend Englewood United Methodist Church. My niece, who is sending this, lives on the border of Englewood and Venice rather far north of me. I need to be able to call these places regularly for no charge. My niece is my only surviving relative and I can not afford to pay to call her, particularly when I need her in emergency situations. I have many friends, acquaintances, and doctors as well as merchants that I call regularly throughout the area. My phone number is 941/474-5612.

I, Caroline McCoy, phone 941/473-4133, live in northern Englewood and like my aunt Annabelle, I already pay long distance charges to Port Charlotte and Punta Gorda and 25 cents a call to Sarasota. I lead a singles ministry group at Englewood United Methodist Church that has 94 members coming from Sarasota, North Port, Punta Gorda, Port Charlotte, Cape Haze, Grove City, Rotonda, and MANY from East Englewood. I also serve on several church committees that require calls throughout the area. It is imperative that I remain in constant contact with my aunt in East Englewood. This area is not highly populated particularly for 9 months of the year and a large majority of its residents live on fixed incomes (even though there are wealthy people who live among us particularly during the 3 winter "season" months). Nearly all of us must go to Port Charlotte or Sarasota to doctors and to merchants to purchase items we need. To separate this area more with long distance or toll charges would be a travesty!

We plead with you--leave things as they are!! Thank you.

We just received a notice from your department about the practice of adding or cramming charges to a telephone bill. We now live in Washington and can not attend any of the meetings, however, we still believe that the MCI billing was incorrect and wish to renew our complaint and investigation.

Last year we filed a complaint and requested an investigation into billings we received from MCI on long distance/international phone calls. We felt that this was definitely in the category of "cramming" as we did not make any of these phone calls. As the result of the investigation, which took a few months, we were told that MCI verified that "the phone calls originated from their phone, therefore, they made the calls".

We were not happy with the results, as you can imagine. However, we were selling a house and planning to buy another and didn't want any negative marks on our credit report. MCI also offered a reduced rate on this billing of 50%, we only had to pay \$103.71 instead of the full bill. This was specified as a limited offer, if we paid the bill now. This seemed to us, to be a form of extortion, especially since we didn't make the calls. However, we paid the bill to preserve our credit report.

We were a victim of this cramming or unauthorized adding of the charges to our phone bill. We want to reopen this case #2048631, as we know the calls were not made from our phone nor did we authorize anyone else to use our phone.


