

Pursuant to City of Jacksonville Mayor John Delaney's letter of December 4, 1995, pleased be advised that the Jacksonville Chamber of Commerce joins the City's action in requesting the Public Service Commission to delay taking action on the matter of the proposed Joint Territorial Settlement Agreement between the Jacksonville Electric Authority (JEA) and Florida Power and Light (FPL).

The Jacksonville Chamber of Commerce is committed to retaining and attracting high value added business and industry in the Northeast Florida area. Our research shows that there is strong correlation between competitive electric rates and high value added manufacturing industry. It has been brought to our attention that we face the potential loss or downsizing of a major Jacksonville manufacturer unless it can obtain access to competitive electric rates such as are under development by the JEA, but apparently are not available from FPL.



The Jacksonville Electric Authority (JEA) recently entered into a joint settlement agreement with Florida Power & Light Company (FPL) that proposes to resolve a territorial dispute initiated by JEA concerning service to electric customers in St. Johns County. While resolving the disputed matters relating to St. John's County to each party's satisfaction, the agreement also would reaffirm the existing territorial boundary line in Clay, Duval and Nassau Counties.

The electricity rates currently charged by FPL to one industrial electric customer within the City of Jacksonville is a concern to the City. These rate levels threaten the loss of this major employer of highly skilled labor in our City to sites in other states, which would have an adverse effect on the Jacksonville economy. This local employer's legal counsel has recently provided a legal analysis to the City of Jacksonville which suggests the City has the legal authority and obligation to direct FPL to cease serving this industrial electric customer in our City. If this analysis is correct, this major employer would then be served by JEA. The local employer, who is threatening to close its plant in our City, advises that they believe JEA's electric rates would enable them to be cost-effective and keep their plant open.

The City of Jacksonville is committed to retaining and attracting desirable sources of economic development. We are, therefore, requesting that you defer action from December 5, until the next regularly scheduled PSC meeting of FPL's and JEA's pending territorial agreement. Your deferral of this pending action will allow time for my staff to analyze this local employer's legal analysis of the City of Jacksonville's rights and obligations in this regard.

On March 20, 1995, Jacksonville Electric Authority (JEA) petitioned the Commission to resolve a territorial dispute with Florida Power and Light Company (FPL). 
