On June 18, 1998, staff filed documents 06508-98, 06509-98 and 06510-98 consisting of certain staff working papers prepared during the staff audit of FPL's Fuel Cost Recovery Clause for the twelve month period ended March 31, 1998. When an audit exit conference was held with the utility on June 15, 1998, the utility requested that these documents be temporarily excepted from public access in accordance with the provisions of Rule 25-22.006 (3)(a)(2), Florida Administrative Code.

On July 6, 1998, the utility filed a request pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, and Chapter 366.093, Florida Statutes, that certain portions of the staff audit working papers prepared during the fuel cost recovery audit receive confidential classification. The utility's filing included edited documents for public inspection (Document 07079-98) and highlighted documents specifying confidential material (Document 07078-98).
