Docket No. 991681-WU; Application for Amendment of Certificate No. 363-W to add territory in Marion County by Sunshine Utilities of Central Florida, Inc.

Dear Ms. Christmas:

After reviewing the application in the above referenced docket, the staff has identified the following deficiencies. Please correct and/or provide additional information as requested.

1. As required by Rule 25-30.036(3)(j), Florida Administrative Code, the utility must provide a statement describing the capacity of the existing lines, the capacity of the treatment facilities and the design of the proposed extension. The utility's response appears to be adequate for the plant capacity. Please provide the capacity of the projected water flows from the additional area. Also, please describing the capacity of the existing lines, proposed lines and explain if fire protection will be provided.

2. As required by Chapter 367.045(2)(b), Florida Statutes, the applicant must provide information on the need or lack of need for service in the area. Although the application indicates there is a need for service, no time frame was provided. Please advise when service will be needed (months or years). Also, indicate the number of customers the utility plans to serve in the Evans Acres subdivision, the nearby area, and the number of requests for potable water service.

3. As required by Rule 25-30.036(3)(f), Florida Administrative Code, the utility must provide one copy of a detailed system map showing the proposed lines, treatment facilities, and the territory proposed to be served. The map shall be of sufficient scale and detail to enable correlation with the description of the territory. Although a map was provided, no treatment facility was on the map. Please resubmit.

4. As required by Rule 25-30.036(3)(i), Florida Administrative Code, the utility must provide one copy of the official county tax assessment map or other map showing township, range

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and section, with a scale such as 1"=200' or 1"=400', with the proposed territory plotted thereon by use of metes and bounds or quarter sections, and with a defined reference point of beginning. We were not able to correlate your description with your map. Please resubmit a map and label all bearings and distances necessary to provide a continuous description.

5. As required by Rule 25-30.036(3)(1), Florida Administrative Code, the utility "must provide a detailed statement regarding the proposed method of financing the construction...." Please submit.

The application indicates that Sunshine Utilities of Central Florida, Inc. plans to provide potable water service to the area. Please explain how these residents obtain wastewater service.

Please file an original and five copies of the requested information no later than February 4, 2000 with the Director, Division of Records and Reporting, 2540 Shumard Oak Boulevard, Tallahassee, FL 32399. Only one copy of each map is required.
