CASE BACKGROUND

- **10/26/93** - This company obtained IXC Certificate No. 3484.
- **12/10/98** - The Division of Administration mailed the regulatory assessment fee (RAF) notice. In accordance with Florida Statute 350.113(4), the Commission "shall provide each regulated company with written notice of the date that payment of the fee is due at least 45 days prior to such date", which would put the due date to February 1, 1999.
- **03/17/99** - The Division of Administration mailed a delinquent letter.

- **10/13/99** - Ms. Stacy Acampora called staff and advised that the past due amount would be paid and that a settlement offer would be proposed.
- **12/03/99** - The Commission received the company's check for the 1998 RAF, including the majority of the statutory penalty and interest charges, settlement proposal and check for \$100 settlement. The company reported no revenues for the period ending December 31, 1998.
- **12/08/99** - Staff called the company and advised that unless the full past due balance was paid, staff could not recommend acceptance of its settlement offer.
- **12/13/99** - The Commission received the balance of the interest charge, which meant the company had paid the past due balance in full.

Staff believes the following recommendations are appropriate.

**DISCUSSION OF ISSUES**

**ISSUE 1:** Should the Commission accept the settlement offer proposed by Telecommunications Service Center, Inc. to resolve the apparent violation of Rule 25-4.0161, Florida Administrative Code, Regulatory Assessment Fees; Telecommunications Companies?

**RECOMMENDATION:** Yes. The Commission should accept the company's settlement proposal. The Commission should forward the contribution to the Office of the Comptroller for deposit in the State General Revenue Fund pursuant to Section 364.285(1), Florida Statutes. (Isler)

**STAFF ANALYSIS:** After the docket was opened, but prior to filing a recommendation, on December 3, 1999, the Commission received a check for the 1998 RAF, most of the penalty and interest charges. In addition, the company paid the \$100 settlement it had offered and proposed to pay future RAFs on a timely basis. On December 13, the Commission received the balance of the outstanding balance.

Accordingly, staff believes the terms of the settlement agreement as summarized in this recommendation should be accepted. The Commission should forward the contribution to the Office of the Comptroller for deposit in the State General Revenue Fund pursuant to Section 364.285(1), Florida Statutes.
