

3. In this docket, the Commission will examine the appropriate regulatory treatment for wholesale sales as well as disclosure requirements for affiliate transactions.

4. FIPUG is an organization of large industrial consumers. The cost of electricity constitutes one of FIPUG's members' largest variable costs. FIPUG members have a substantial interest in ensuring that wholesales are treated in a manner that is not harmful to retail ratepayers. FIPUG members also have a substantial interest in reviewing affiliate transactions to ensure that such transactions do not damage retail ratepayers.


