DISCUSSION OF ISSUES

ISSUE 1: Should the Commission suspend Florida Power Corporation's (FPC) petition for approval of its demand-side management plan?

RECOMMENDATION: Yes. The Commission should suspend FPC's petition for approval of its demand-side management plan.

STAFF ANALYSIS: Pursuant to Rule 25-17.0021, Florida Administrative Code, FPL submitted a Demand Side Management Plan designed to meet the conservation goals established by the Commission in Order No. PSC-99-1942-FOF-EG. Because of the extensive nature of the filing, staff recommends that the proposed tariff revision be suspended to allow staff the opportunity to request more supporting data, and additional time to evaluate the petition.
