Telecarrier Services Inc. ("TSI") is being acquired by eLEC Communications Corp ("eLEC") and will operate as a wholly owned subsidiary of eLEC. This transaction will be transparent to the customer base. The company name, rates and tariff remain the same.

eLEC is a Delaware corporation with its principal place of business at 37 North Street, Norwalk, Connecticut 06851. eLEC's stock is publicly traded on the NASDAQ Exchange. eLEC is a communications company that focuses on developing integrated suite of telecommunications and internet products and services. Subsidiaries include Essex Communications, a New York based provider of local, interexchange, and internet services; Webquill Internet Services based in Norwalk Connecticut, provides nation wide dial-up internet access, dedicated internet access, Web Application Design, Hosting, and E-Commerce solutions; and Airline Ventures, Inc. in Texas a retail and E-Commerce store targeted to professional flight crew members offering name brand luggage, apparel and other travel related accessories as well as job related necessities.

Upon consummation of the transfer of control, TSI will continue operating under its current name. This transfer of control will not in any way disrupt service nor cause inconvenience or confusion to TSI's customers. In fact, the transfer of control will be virtually seamless to customers in terms of their services. The rates, terms, and conditions of service for TSI's customers will remain the same. The companies expect to consummate the transfer of control subject to the approval of various state authorities, and satisfaction of other customary conditions.
