Re: Approval of an Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement Negotiated by BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth") and ACCESS Integrated Networks, Inc. pursuant to Sections 251, 252 and 271 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996

Dear Mrs. Bayo:

Pursuant to section 252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996, BellSouth and ACCESS Integrated Networks, Inc. are submitting to the Florida Public Service Commission an amendment to their negotiated agreement for the interconnection of their networks, the unbundling of specific network elements offered by BellSouth and the resale of BellSouth's telecommunications services to ACCESS Integrated Networks, Inc. The Commission approved the initial agreement between the companies in Order No. 99-2363-FOF-TP issued December 3, 1999 in Docket 991484-TP.

Pursuant to section 252(e) of the Act, the Commission is charged with approving or rejecting the negotiated agreement between BellSouth and ACCESS Integrated Networks, Inc. within 90 days of its submission. The Act provides that the Commission may only reject such an agreement if it finds that the agreement or any portion of the agreement discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement or the implementation of the agreement or any portion of the agreement is not consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity. Both parties aver that neither of these reasons exist as to the agreement they have negotiated and therefore, are very hopeful that the Commission shall approve their agreement.

**Amendment
to Interconnection Agreement Between
BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc.
and ACCESS Integrated Networks, Inc.
Dated August 31, 1999**


Pursuant to this Agreement (the "Amendment"), BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth") and ACCESS Integrated Networks, Inc. ("ACCESS Integrated") hereinafter referred to collectively as the "Parties" hereby agree to amend that certain Interconnection Agreement between the Parties dated August 31, 1999 ("the Agreement")

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual provisions contained herein and other good and valuable consideration the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, BellSouth and ACCESS Integrated hereby covenant and agree as follows:

1. Section 15.3, Modification of Agreement, is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with new language as follows:
 - 15.1 BellSouth shall make available, pursuant to 47 USC § 252 and the FCC rules and regulations regarding such availability to CLEC-t any interconnection service or network element provided under any other agreement filed and approved pursuant to 47 USC § 252. The Parties shall adopt all rates, terms and conditions concerning such other interconnection service or network element and any other rates, terms and conditions that are interrelated or were negotiated in exchange for or in conjunction with the interconnection service or network element being adopted. The adopted interconnection service, or network element and agreement shall apply to the same states as such other agreement and for the identical term of such other agreement.
2. The Parties agree that all of the other provisions of the Agreement, shall remain in full force and effect.
3. The Parties further agree that either or both of the Parties is authorized to submit this Amendment to the applicable Public Service Commission or other regulatory body having jurisdiction over the subject matter of this Amendment, for approval subject to Section 252(e) of the federal Telecommunications Act of 1996.
