BELLSOUTH TELECOMMUNICATIONS, INC.'S NOTICE OF INTENT TO REQUEST SPECIFIED CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

COMES NOW, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth" or "Company"), and pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, files its Notice of Intent to Request Specified Confidential Classification.

1. On January 5, 2000, BlueStar Networks, Inc. ("BlueStar") served its First Set of Interrogatories and First Request for Production of Documents to BellSouth. On January 18, 2000, BellSouth filed its General and Specific Objections to that discovery and on January 25, 2000, BellSouth served its Responses and Objections to that discovery. On February 10, 2000, BellSouth served its Notice of Intent for copies of certain documents responsive to Requests for Production Nos. 2, 3, 8, 10, 11, 13, 14 and 18. The copies were documents designated by BlueStar for copying after inspecting the documents made available by BellSouth in response to BlueStar's discovery requests.

2. At BlueStar's request, BellSouth is now providing copies of additional documents (approximately 3,000 pages as well as two CD Roms) from the original document production. The copies include documents responsive to Request for Production Nos. 8, 10, 11, 13 and 14. The information contained in BellSouth's response to Request for Production Nos. 8, 10, 11, 13 and 14 is

proprietary and includes vendor specific information and vendor specific pricing information that could cause competitive harm to BellSouth and is clearly confidential and proprietary under Florida Statutes, Section 364.183.

3. On February 14, 2000, BellSouth provided copies of these documents to BlueStar. Staff has a standing request for copies of any documents BlueStar designates for copying after inspecting BellSouth's document production. Some of the information contained in these documents is proprietary and includes vendor specific information and vendor specific pricing information.

4. Because this information is proprietary, BellSouth is now filing this Notice of Intent to Request Specified Confidential Classification pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(3)(a), Florida Administrative Code, in order to allow the Commission to take possession of the designated copies without delay. The original of this notice has been filed with the Division of Records and Reporting, and a copy has been served on all parties of record.
