RE: DOCKET NO. 991546-TC (Item 16 - 02/01/00 Agenda Conference) - CANCELLATION BY FLORIDA PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION OF INTEREXCHANGE TELECOMMUNICATIONS CERTIFICATE NO. 4751 ISSUED TO CAPITAL SERVICES OF SOUTH FLORIDA, INC. FOR VIOLATION OF RULE 25-4.0161, F.A.C., REGULATORY ASSESSMENT FEES; TELECOMMUNICATIONS COMPANIES.

At the February 1, 2000, Agenda Conference, the Commission approved staff's recommendation to fine or cancel the company's certificate in the above-referenced docket. On February 2, 2000, the Division of Telecommunications received a notice that Capital Services of South Florida, Inc. had filed for reorganization under Chapter 11, Bankruptcy. Therefore, we are prevented by the automatic stay provision of the Bankruptcy Code from taking action against this company for its failure to pay Regulatory Assessment Fees at this time.

For the reason described above, the Order reflecting the vote, due to be filed on February 21, 2000, will not be issued. Staff will be filing a recommendation for the March 28, 2000, Agenda Conference to address the disposition of this matter and an Order consistent with the Commission's decision will be issued.
