

NOTICE is hereby given pursuant to Section 120.54, Florida Statutes, that the Florida Public Service Commission staff has initiated the repeal of Rule 25-30.470, Florida Administrative Code, to repeal provisions relating to the reduction of rates after the amortization period for rate case expense expires.

The attached Notice of Proposed Rule Development will appear in the March 3, 2000, edition of the Florida Administrative Weekly. If timely requested and not deemed unnecessary by the Commission, a rule development workshop will be held at a time and place that will be announced.

The annual amount of rate case expense, which is equal to one-fourth of the total allowed rate case expense, shall be divided by the regulatory assessment fee gross up factor. The resulting number shall then be divided by the revenue requirement to determine the percentage of the rate reduction. The percentage is then multiplied against the new rates to determine the amount of the future rate reduction. Revised tariff sheets implementing the reduction shall be filed no later than 1 month before the end of the fourth year.~~
