If all parties and all counsel submit such letters, this Notice and all responses will be made part of the record, as required by Canon 3D of the Code of Judicial Conduct, and Commissioner Jaber will continue participation in the proceeding.

If waivers are not received from all parties and all counsel, the responses will not be shown to Commissioner Jaber nor will Commissioner Jaber be informed of the identity of any party or lawyer who declined to waive the disqualification. If the disqualification is not waived, this case will be reassigned.


