In making its determination, the Commission must take into account the need for electric system reliability and integrity, the need for the adequate electricity at a reason; ble cost, and whether the proposed plant is the most cost-effective afternative available. The Commission must also expressly consider the conservation measure taken by or reasonably available to the petitioner which might might be proposed plant, and other matters within its jurisdiction vinich it deems relevant. The Commission's determination of need for the Okeechobee County facility shall create a presumption of public need and neces sity and shall serve as the Commission's report as required by Section 403.507(2) (a) (2). Florida Statutes, An order entered by the Commission pursuant to this hearing shall constitute final agency action.

Only issues relating to the need for the power plant and its associated facilities will be heard at the March 20-22, 2000, hearing. Separate public hearings will be held before the Division of Administrative Hearings to consider environmental and other impacts of the proposed plant and associated facilities.

Members of the public who are not parties to the need determination proceeding will have an opportunity to present testimony regarding the need for the proposed plant and associated facilities. The proposed plant is to be located north-northeast of Lake Okeechobee, an proximately five miles southeast of the City of Okeechobee, in Okeechobee County, Florida. The site is located west of Nubbin Slough on the north side of Stitle Road 710. The proposed unit consists of two combustion turbine generators, two heat recovery steam generators, two steam turbine generators, and a ssociated facilities. The proposed plant is estimated to commence commercial operation in April 2003.
