Issue 1: Should the Commission impose a \$500 fine or cancel the alternative local exchange telecommunications' certificates issued to each company listed on page 5 of staff's memorandum dated March 16, 2000, for apparent violation of Rule 25-4.0161, Florida Administrative Code, Regulatory Assessment Fees; Telecommunications Companies?

Recommendation: Yes. The Commission should impose a \$500 fine or cancel each company's certificate as listed on page 5 if the fine and the regulatory assessment fees, including statutory penalty and interest charges, are not received by the Commission within five business days after issuance of the Consummating Order. The fine should be paid to the Florida Public Service Commission and forwarded to the Office of the Comptroller for deposit in the State General Revenue Fund pursuant to Section 364.285(1), Florida Statutes. If the Commission's Order is not protested

and the fine and regulatory assessment fees, including statutory penalty and interest charges, are not received, the alternative local exchange telecommunications certificate numbers listed on page 5 should be canceled administratively.

Issue 2: Should these dockets be closed?

Recommendation: Yes. If the Commission approves or modifies staff's recommendation on Issue 1, these dockets should be closed upon receipt of the fine and fees or cancellation of the certificates, unless a person whose substantial interests are affected by the Commission's decision files a protest within 21 days of issuance of the proposed agency action order. If the Commission denies staff's recommendation on Issue 1, these dockets should be closed administratively. A protest in one docket should not prevent the action in a separate docket from becoming final.
