RE: DOCKET NO. 000109-TI - Investigation and determination of appropriate method for refunding interest and overcharges on intrastate 0+ calls made from pay telephones and in a call aggregator context by International Tele-Services, Inc. d/b/a InTeleServ.

Issue 1: Should the Commission accept International Tele-Services, Inc. d/b/a InTeleServ's offer of refund and refund calculation of \$3,381.00, plus interest of \$228.64, for a total of \$3,609.64, for overcharging end users on intrastate 0+ calls made from pay telephones and in a call aggregator context from February 1, 1999, through August 19, 1999?

Recommendation: Yes. The Commission should accept InTeleServ's refund calculation of \$3,381.00, adding interest of \$228.64, for a total of \$3,609.64, and proposal to credit end user customers' local exchange telephone bills beginning June 1, 2000, and ending July 31, 2000, for overcharging end users on intrastate 0+ calls made from pay telephones and in a call aggregator context from February 1, 1999, through August 19, 1999. 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interest, should be remitted to the Commission by August 10, 2000, and forwarded to the Comptroller for deposit in the General Revenue Fund, pursuant to Section 364.285(1), Florida Statutes. InTeleServ should submit a final report as required by Rule 25-4.114, Florida Administrative Code, Refunds, by August 10, 2000.
