DISCUSSION OF ISSUES

ISSUE 1: Should the Commission suspend Florida Power & Light Company's petition to revise its Curtailable Service tariff?

Staff recommends that the proposed tariff be suspended to allow staff the opportunity to request more supporting data, and additional time to evaluate the
