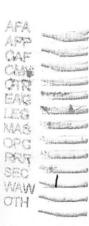

In reference to Docket No. 990675-TI, Gulf Long Distance, in compliance with Rule 25-4.114 (7), Refunds, Florida Administrative Code, would like to report the following:

- In August, 1999, Gulf Long Distance transmitted a refund amount totaling \$88,016.55 to Billing Concepts (ZPDI).
- In September, 1999, it was determined that the amounts to be refunded to the customers
 would be done so by the local exchange carrier issuing a credit on the customer's local
 telephone bill. The credit amounts to be refunded by the local exchange carriers were as
 follows:

BellSouth - \$73,722.66 (83.76%) GTE South - \$9,074.51 (10.31%) United Florida - \$1,645.91 (1.87%) Other Independents - \$3,573.47 (4.06%)

- In October, 1999, ZPDI reported that all but \$1.53 had successfully been issued to the local exchange carriers for refund.
- In November, 1999, ZPDI reported that \$62,205.92, of the \$88,016.55, was successfully credited to the customer. The amounts that were not refunded are as follows:

BellSouth - \$25,504.07 GTE South - \$6.10 United Florida - \$0.76 Other Independents - \$300.00

In December, 1999, the customer service group at Gulf Long Distance reported that it was still
receiving calls from customers that were not issued a credit/refund. To insure that these
customers received the proper credit due to them, we asked that the docket remain open.
 Gulf Long Distance has not received any new requests for refunds due to this matter since the
end of December, 1999.

That said, Gulf Long Distance has issued a check in the amount of the remaining \$25,810.93 to the Florida Public Service Commission pursuant to Rule 25-4.114(8), Refunds, Florida Administrative Code. We ask that Docket No. 990675-TI be officially closed.

Of the \$25,810.93 that was rejected, \$25,504.07 was rejected by BellSouth, \$6.10 by GTE South, and \$.76 by United Florida. We continue to work with Billing Concepts, as well as BellSouth, in an effort to determine the reasons for the amount of credits that were rejected.

Due to the fact that we are still receiving calls to our customer service group from customers that seem to have been rejected by BellSouth, we feel that the best way to insure that these customers receive a credit is to issue a check in the amount of the credit. • In December, 1999, the customer service group at Gulf Long Distance reported that it was still receiving calls from customers that were not issued a credit/refund. To insure that these customers received the proper credit due to them, we asked that the docket remain open. Gulf Long Distance has not received any new requests for refunds due to this matter since the end of December, 1999.

That said, Gulf Long Distance has issued a check in the amount of the remaining \$25,810.93 to the Florida Public Service Commission pursuant to Rule 25-4.114(8), Refunds, Florida Administrative Code. We ask that Docket No. 990675-TI be officially closed.
