

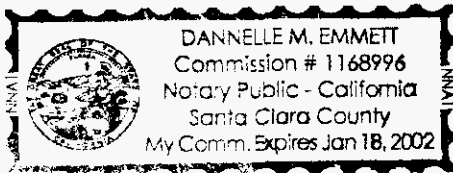



Jagdeep joined Ciena, a \$500 million leader in the optical communications equipment market, after its acquisition of Lightera Networks for \$550 million. At Lightera, Jagdeep served as President and CEO, and led the company from startup to a leadership position in the market for optical switching equipment for telecommunications carrier networks.


