**GTE FLORIDA INCORPORATED'S REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL
CLASSIFICATION AND MOTION FOR PROTECTIVE ORDER**

Under Commission Rule 25-22.006, GTE Florida Incorporated (GTE) seeks confidential classification and a protective order for certain information contained in its recurring cost study filed April 17, 2000 in this proceeding.

All of the information for which GTE seeks confidential treatment falls within Florida Statutes section 364.183(3)(e), which defines the term, "proprietary confidential business information," to include "information relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider of information." The confidential information concerns GTE's cost to provide network elements and services, including third-party confidential data. If competitors are able to acquire this detailed and sensitive costing information regarding GTE, they could more easily develop entry and marketing strategies to ensure success in competing with GTE. These competitors would be more adept at pricing their own services if they possess details about GTE's cost structure. This affords them an unfair advantage while severely jeopardizing GTE's competitive position. In a competitive business, any knowledge obtained about a competitor can be used to the detriment of the entity to which it pertains, often in ways that cannot be fully anticipated. This unfair advantage skews the operation of the market, to the ultimate detriment of the telecommunications consumer.





ATTACHMENT I – EXPLANATIONS

1. The information contained in these pages constitutes, is derived from (using the code, algorithms and mapping that is not designated as confidential), or is based on proprietary and confidential information provided to GTE by its third party vendors. GTE's contractual obligations to those parties include the obligation not to disclose or distribute such proprietary or confidential information. Aside from violating contract terms, disclosure of this information would harm GTE's future ability to contract for goods and/or services on favorable terms. Confidential third-party vendor information has been made available for review to other parties in this proceeding only under the terms of a protective agreement among GTE, the third parties, and the reviewing party.

2. These figures detail GTE's outside plant, structure sharing, second line information, residential and business line penetration and forecasted line growth. This detail consists of historical trends and future estimates. Cost information of this nature will give competitors an artificial competitive advantage in offering services where GTE expects growth and to avoid offering competitive services in slower-growth areas.

3. This information is developed through the results of the SCIS and COSTMOD systems. The formulas are specific to each central office switch vendor and include information covered by proprietary agreements. Disclosure of these data would violate GTE's contracts with its third party vendors and harm GTE's ability to continue negotiating favorable contract terms.

4. These pages contain central office, traffic-sensitive data and outside-plant specific data. Disclosure of this information gives competitors an unfair advantage in designing their networks and in competing against GTE in the most efficient manner. The fact that GTE cannot obtain such knowledge about its competitors exacerbates the unfairness of disclosing this detailed cost information.

5. These pages contain central office and outside-plant specific data. Disclosure of this information gives competitors an unfair advantage in designing their networks and in competing against GTE in the most efficient manner. The fact that GTE cannot obtain such knowledge about its competitors exacerbates the unfairness of disclosing this detailed cost information.

6. These pages contain outside plant specific data as well as labor rates. Disclosure of this information would allow competitors to determine GTE's most lucrative areas and plan their entry and expansion accordingly. The fact that GTE cannot obtain these kind of detailed data from competitors exacerbates the unfairness of disclosing this detailed cost information.

7. These pages contain the detailed cost components underlying discrete basic network functions. Disclosure of such detailed costs for such small pieces of the network would give competitors an advantage in designing their networks and in competing against GTE in the most efficient manner. The fact that GTE cannot obtain such knowledge about its competitors exacerbates the unfairness of disclosing this detailed cost information.

8. These pages represent SS7 traffic sensitive data and SS7 Guidelines detailing GTE's SS7 network functionalities developed using that data. Actual and potential competitors can use these cost data in designing their own network and services in the way that will best ensure success with GTE, without the usual marketplace trial and error.

9. These pages represent GTE's three-year average material loading cost factors and composite labor rates. Disclosure of such detailed expense factors allows competitors to unfairly compete with GTE for employees in a tight labor market. The fact that GTE cannot obtain such knowledge about its competitors exacerbates the unfairness of disclosing this detailed expense information.

10. The information contained within these pages is derived from specific GTE Work Center detail available only from GTE's internal financial systems. Disclosure of information at this level of detail would provide external firms with a competitive advantage by being able to evaluate the detailed and specific cost structure of GTE's operations. At the same time, the competitive disadvantage is compounded because GTE is not provided access to the same level of detail of a competitor's operating expenses. This inequity would provide competitors with a distinct, competitive advantage in the market place. This information should, therefore, not be made publicly available.
