RE: DOCKET NO. 980281-TP - Complaint of MCI Metro Access Transmission Services, Inc. against BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. for breach of approved interconnection agreement.

Issue 1: Should the Commission grant MCImetro Access Transmission Services, LLC's Motion to Enforce Commission Orders?

Recommendation: Yes. Staff recommends that the Commission grant MCIm's Motion to Enforce Commission Orders by prohibiting BellSouth from requiring MCIm to execute a license agreement prior to the release of the Regional Street Address Guide (RSAG) download data base. However, staff recommends that restricting MCIm's use of the RSAG download to address validation for local telecommunications service to be consistent with the record in this case. In addition, staff recommends that MCIm should not attempt to sell the data on the open market. Finally, staff recommends that the RSAG download data provided to MCIm should not be transferred to any entity, including affiliates.
