RE: DOCKET NO. 991222-TP - Request for submission of proposals for relay service, beginning in June 2000, for the hearing and speech impaired, and other implementation matters in compliance with the Florida Telecommunications Access System Act of 1991.

Issue 1: Should Florida Telecommunications Relay, Inc.'s proposed budget for the fiscal year 2000-2001 be approved effective July 1, 2000 as proposed by FTRI?

Recommendation: No. Florida Telecommunications Relay, Inc.'s proposed budget (Attachment A of staff's May 4, 2000 memorandum) for fiscal year 2000-2001 should be modified to reflect a surcharge of \$.08 per access line.

Local exchange telephone companies and alternative local exchange companies should be ordered to assess an \$.08 surcharge beginning July 1, 2000.

As is the case today, the budget shall be grouped into five categories. FTRI may move amounts between these five categories not to exceed 10% of the category from which the funds are being moved; greater movement would require prior Commission authorization.
