

**In response to John Williams' letter of April 20, 2000 in the above-referenced docket, North Fort Myers Utility, Inc. provides the following additional information:**



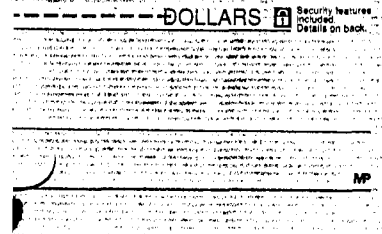
