COMES NOW BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth"), and hereby files, pursuant to the Florida Administrative Code, its Motion For Extension of Duration of Order Granting Request For Confidential Classification, and states the following:

1. On March 10, 1998, BellSouth filed a Request for Confidential
