Billing Group, Inc., to Orion Technologies, Inc.

Dear Sir:

Special Accounts Billing Group, Inc. ("SABG") by its attorneys, hereby notifies the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") of the proposed transfer of control of SABG from its current shareholder, Mr. James S. Grabowski, to Orion Technologies, Inc. ("Orion") through a merger with Globalinx Corporation ("Globalinx"), a subsidiary of Orion. It is our understanding that under the circumstances set forth below, no formal approval of the Commission is required for this transaction.

SABG, an Illinois corporation, is currently authorized to provide intrastate toll telecommunication services in Florida.¹ SABG is currently authorized as a reseller of intrastate, interexchange telecommunications services in 46 states. It also is authorized by the Federal Communications Commission to resell interstate and international service.

Orion is an international holding company concentrating on Internet and telecommunications-based technologies and services for e-commerce and business-to-business markets. Orion's wholly owned subsidiary Globalinx is an international telecommunications company providing bundled wireless, satellite, and terrestrial communications products and services for instant and secure voice, data, and video transmission to commercial clients worldwide.

On May 26, 2000, Orion and SABG entered into a Merger Agreement whereby SABG will be merged with and into Globalinx. Following the merger, Globalinx will continue as the surviving corporation.

The transfer of control of SABG from its current shareholder to Orion is in the public interest. The addition of SABG to Orion's other interests will enhance both Orion and SABG's ability to compete in the market for telecommunication services in Florida and elsewhere. The benefit from increased economies of scale will permit SABG to operate more efficiently and thus to compete more effectively.

In addition, SABG will have access to the financial resources it needs to introduce new products and services and to respond to competition in the competitive telecommunications environment in Florida. Over time, consumers in Florida will benefit from a greater number of products and service options, as well as lower prices.
