RE: Application for Authority to Transfer Ownership or Control of Single Billing Services, Inc. d/b/a Asian American Association to New Global Telecom, Inc.

Dear Sir:

Single Billing Services, Inc. d/b/a Asian American Association ("AAA") by its attorneys, hereby notifies the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") of the proposed transfer of control of AAA from its current shareholder, Ms. Helen Shih, to New Global Telecom, Inc. ("NGT"). It is our understanding that under the circumstances set forth below, no formal approval of the Commission is required for this transaction.

AAA, a Delaware corporation, is currently authorized to provide intrastate toll telecommunication services in Florida.¹ AAA is currently authorized as a reseller of intrastate, interexchange telecommunications services in 45 states. It also is authorized by the Federal Communications Commission to resell interstate and international service.

NGT is an international facilities-based carrier, providing wholesale and retail voice and data services worldwide.

On May 8, 2000, AAA and NGT entered into a Stock Conveyance Agreement whereby Ms. Shih will transfer all of her right, title, and interest in and to AAA to NGT. The transfer of control of AAA from its current shareholder to NGT is in the public interest. The addition of AAA to NGT's other interests will enhance both NGT and AAA's ability to compete in the market for telecommunication services in Florida and elsewhere. After the transaction, AAA will continue to operate as it has in the past, using the same names, tariff, and operating authority. NGT intends to retain all key AAA personnel, including certain senior management personnel. Thus, the transfer of ownership or control will be transparent to, and have no adverse impact upon the

AAA customers. The benefit from increased economies of scale will permit AAA to operate more efficiently and thus to compete more effectively.

As a result of this transaction, AAA will have access to the financial resources it needs to introduce new products and services and to respond to competition in the competitive telecommunications environment in Florida. Over time, consumers in Florida will benefit from a greater number of products and service options, as well as lower prices.
