

PURPOSE AND PROCEDURE

The purpose of this hearing is to consider the complaint of  
Allied Universal Corporation and Chemical Formulators, Inc.  
against Tampa Electric Company, alleging violations of Sections



366.03, 366.06(2), and 366.07, Florida Statutes. The Commission will also consider any motions or other matters pending at the time of the hearing. The Commission may rule on any such motions from the bench or may take the matters under advisement.

At the hearing, all parties shall be given the opportunity to present testimony and other evidence on the issues identified by the parties at the prehearing conference held on July 6, 2000. All witnesses shall be subject to cross-examination at the conclusion of their testimony.


