PURPOSE AND PROCEDURE

This matter has been set for hearing to consider the protests filed to Order No. PSC-99-1940-PAA-EI, issued October 1, 1999, and Order No. PSC-99-2007-PAA-EI, issued October 14, 1999, by the Florida Industrial Power Users Group and Tampa Electric Company, and to address any motions or other matters that may be pending at the time of the hearing. The Commission may rule on any such motions from the bench or may take the matters under advisement.

At the hearing, all parties shall be given the opportunity to present testimony and other evidence on the issues identified by the parties at the prehearing conference held on July 12, 2000. All witnesses shall be subject to cross-examination at the conclusion of their testimony.
