RE: DOCKET NO. 000315-WS - Application by United Water Florida Inc. for approval of tariff sheets for wholesale water and wastewater service in St. Johns County.

Issue 1: Should UWF's application for Approval of Tariff Sheets for Wholesale Water and Wastewater be approved?

Recommendation: UWF's application should not be ruled upon because the contemplated transaction between UWF and St. Joe and the resulting new class of service is exempt from the Commission's regulation pursuant to Section 367.022(12), Florida Statutes. For future ratemaking considerations, staff recommends that the utility's cost of providing wholesale water and wastewater service to St. Joe should not be subsidized by the jurisdictional customers. Also, staff recommends that the revenues generated from the wholesale water and wastewater service should not be considered in any proceedings involving the utility before the Commission.
