Yesterday, I received a copy of the letter from Seminole Electric Cooperative's attorney, Richard D. Melson, to the Division of Records and Reporting concerning the confidential status of certain documents filed by Lee County Electric Cooperative as testimony exhibits under a Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification in the above referenced docket. Mr. Melson states in his letter that Lee County filed these documents on a confidential basis in order to allow Seminole the opportunity to determine whether the documents contained confidential business information to Seminole.
