("BellSouth" or "Company"), and files, pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(6)(c), Florida Administrative Code, its Motion for Temporary Protective Order in connection with its Responses to Florida's Citizens' ("Citizens'") Third Set of Interrogatories, dated June 16, 2000.

On July 19, 2000, BellSouth served its Responses to Citizens' Third Set of Interrogatories, which are deemed to be confidential and proprietary by BellSouth. The information that will be conveyed to and reviewed by Citizens' in connection with the responses to these interrogatories includes proprietary, confidential business information which should not be publicly disclosed. Protective Order specifically addressing each of the documents identified in accordance with Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code.


