RE: DOCKET NO. 000229-TX - Initiation of show cause proceedings against Burno Inc. d/b/a Integra Paging for apparent violation of Section 364.183(1), F.S., Access to Company Records.

Issue 1: Should the Commission accept the settlement offer proposed by Burno Inc. d/b/a Integra Paging to resolve the apparent violation of Section 364.183(1), Florida Statutes, Access to Company Records?

Recommendation: Yes. The Commission should accept the company's settlement proposal. Any contribution should be received by the Commission within twenty business days from the issuance date of the Commission Order and should identify the docket number and company name. The Commission should forward the contribution to the Office of the Comptroller for deposit in the State of Florida General Revenue Fund pursuant to Section 364.285 (1), Florida Statutes. If the company fails to pay in accordance with the terms of the settlement offer, the company's certificate should be canceled, and this docket should be closed.
