DISCUSSION OF ISSUES

ISSUE 1: Should the Commission suspend Florida Power & Light Company's (FPL) proposed revisions to its Experimental Real Time Pricing tariff?

RECOMMENDATION: Yes. The Commission should suspend FPL's proposed revisions to its Experimental Real Time Pricing tariff. [SPRINGER, E. DRAPER]

STAFF ANALYSIS: On July 20, 2000, FPL filed a petition for approval of modification and extension of Experimental Real Time Pricing Rate. FPL's petition includes technical modifications that require in-depth discovery. Staff requests additional time to properly address these modifications.

Pursuant to Section 366.06(3), Florida Statutes, the Commission may withhold consent to the operation of all or any

portion of a new rate schedule, delivering to the utility requesting such increase, within 60 days, a reason or written statement of good cause for doing so. Staff recommends that proposed tariffs be suspended to allow staff additional time to evaluate the petition. Staff believes this is good cause, consistent with the requirement of Section 366.06(3), Florida Statutes.

ISSUE 2: Should this docket be closed?

RECOMMENDATION: No. The docket should remain open pending a final decision on the tariff. [HART]
