
Sunshine Utilities of Central Florida, Inc. ("Sunshine"), after discussing the referenced application with the FPSC staff, is in the process of analyzing and evaluating various alternatives to its proposed water system improvements. Although Sunshine expected to file an amended application with the FPSC on or before August 15, 2000, Sunshine needs additional time to complete the schedules to its amended application. This will confirm that we have agreed that Sunshine will file its amended application on or before September 8, 2000. We understand that this extension of time may cause the Case Assignment and Scheduling Record in this proceeding to be revised. However, as we have discussed, we trust that a final decision in this docket will be made prior to February 1, 2001, so that Sunshine can submit a complete grant and loan application to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection in time to meet that agency's next available funding cycle.
