

Director,

This letter is in response to an application by **United Water Florida, Inc.** to the **Florida Public Service Commission** to extend their water/sewer lines through our community. It will cost between \$8,000.00-\$15,000.00 per resident to tie into the service along with monthly water/sewer fees and the cost per linear foot of water/sewer pipe that is laid on our road frontage. It also may be made mandatory for each resident, once the lines are in to tie into the service.

We are absolutely opposed to this and do not want these water/sewer lines to come through Blackrock Road North and we feel it is unfair to allow this to happen without our approval. I am retired and can not afford the cost or afford to take out a loan to pay for my part of this project. Presently we have a well and a septic tank and we are satisfied with this and see no sound reason to change over to other utilities and have to be made to bear this burden if this is approved by the **Florida Pubic Service Commission**.
