Dear Director,

We do hereby object to the application of United Water Florida, Inc. to extend their service area located in Nassau County, Florida as set forth in the legal notice on page 6C of the Fernandina Beach Newsleader dated August 30, 2000, on the following grounds:

1. The area sought in the extension is too broad.
2. The area sought in the extension is low density. There is no demand yet for this service.
3. If granted, this service will contribute to "urban sprawl" which is a violation of our Comprehensive Plan.
4. This service is being sought to accommodate one developer and if granted may, now or in the future, create incredible financial hardships for every man, woman, and child in my community.
5. No information has been given to the public or the residents in the area affected as to the cost, the benefits, the timetable or any other details.

Please take into account that many of the families in this community have not been properly notified that they will be the ones footing the bill for this project in some shape or form. It may be having to tie into the system, being billed monthly for the "privilege" of using a system that they never asked for in the first place or it may be an increase in their taxes. The developers will build their homes, make the big bucks and leave the taxpayers of this community to deal with the financial burden. Please do not let our community be destroyed by "Big Business" whose only concern is making money.
