2. If granted, this service will contribute to "urban sprawl" which is a violation of our Comprehensive Plan.
3. This service is being sought to accommodate one developer and if granted may, now or in the future, create incredible hardships for everyone in our community.
4. The area in the extension is too broad.
5. No information has been given to the public or the residents in the area affected as to the cost, the benefits, the timetable, or any other details.
