This is in response to your letter dated September 20, 2000 concerning docket number 001318-TI. We have remitted the Regulatory Assessment fee of \$50.00, penalty for late payment of \$12.50 and interest for late payment of \$4.00 to the Florida Public Service Commission.

The employee that was in charge of regulatory matters ceased to work for Legends in May 2000, and these duties have recently been given to another employee to ensure that all regulatory filings, fees, etc. are paid and filed in a timely manner.
