**PETITION FOR APPROVAL OF  
FLORIDA PUBLIC UTILITIES COMPANY'S  
CONSERVATION COST RECOVERY FACTOR**

Florida Public Utilities Company ("the Company"), through its undersigned attorneys and pursuant to the requirements of this docket, hereby petitions the Commission for approval of the Company's conservation cost recovery factors for each of its two electric divisions for the period January, 2001 through December, 2001. In support hereof, the Company states:

- 3) Pursuant to the requirements of this Docket, the Company has prefiled the conservation cost recovery forms supplied by the Electric & Gas Department in a manner consistent with the Department's instructions.

- 4) As indicated in the prefiled forms, the recoverable conservation costs for the period January 2001 through December 2001 are projected to be \$169,200 for the Marianna division and \$177,163 for the Fernandina Beach division. The estimated conservation cost recovery true-up

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amounts for the period January 2000 through December 2000 are projected to be an underrecovery of \$8,378 for the Marianna division and an underrecovery of \$21,918 for the Fernandina Beach division. These amounts are based upon eight months actual and four months estimated data.

5) The resulting net total projected conservation costs to be recovered for the period January 2001 through December 2001 are \$160,822 for the Marianna division and \$155,245 for the Fernandina Beach division. Based upon the projected sales for each respective division the appropriate levelized conservation cost recovery factors for the period January 2001 through December 2001 are \$.00056 per KWH for the Marianna division and \$.00038 per KWH for the Fernandina Beach division.

WHEREFORE, Florida Public Utilities Company petitions the Commission to approve the foregoing conservation cost recovery factors, to be applied to customer bills for the period January, 2001 through December, 2001, and to billings thereafter until other conservation cost recovery factors are approved by the Commission.


