RE: DOCKET NO. 000258-TL - Investigation into telephone exchange boundary issues in St. Augustine and Palm Coast exchanges (Daytona Beach and Jacksonville LATA boundaries).

Issue 1: Based on the results of the subscriber survey, should the customers in the Flagler County pocket of the St. Augustine exchange be transferred to the Palm Coast exchange?

Recommendation: No. Based on the results of the subscriber survey, staff recommends that the customers should not be transferred. The survey results, which are summarized in Table A of staff's September 14, 2000 memorandum, indicate that, although a sufficient number of ballots were returned to satisfy the criteria specified in Order No. PSC-00-0825-PAA-TL, the majority chose not to be transferred.
