RE: DOCKET NO. 001005-TC - Cancellation by Florida Public Service Commission of Pay Telephone Certificate No. 5069 issued to Gang of Five, Inc. d/b/a Club Five for violation of Rule No. 25-4.0161, F.A.C., Regulatory Assessment Fees; Telecommunications Companies.

Issue 1: Should the Commission grant Gang of Five, Inc. d/b/a Club Five a voluntary cancellation of PATS Certificate No. 5069?

Recommendation: No. The Commission should not grant the company a voluntary cancellation of its pay telephone certificate. The Commission should cancel the company's Certificate No. 5069 on its own motion, effective on the date of issuance of the Consummating Order. In the event the company fails to pay the past due fees, the collection of the fees should be referred to the Comptroller's Office for further collection efforts.
