We reserve the right to object after further information is given to us.

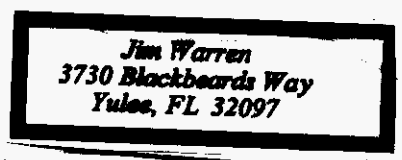
We join in the objections of Susan Ward Davis (September 12, 2000) and Janice Allison Sanderson (September 1, 2000) copies of which are enclosed.

To whom it may concern,

It has come to my attention that United Water Florida, Inc. has applied to extend their water/sewer lines through my community. I STRONGLY object to the proposal that affected residences may have to tie into this line, whether we want to or not, at a cost well beyond the reach of most of us. I consider this an infringement of my personal liberty. This is a community of a few very wealthy people, but the vast majority of us are not wealthy at all, and the anticipated costs represent a huge percentage of the values of our properties. It is very unlikely that our property values will increase accordingly, and we are therefore very likely to incur financial loss as well as financial burden.

More than anything, I object to the underhand way in which these plans have been undertaken. They have obviously been in the air for sometime, yet affected residents were not informed. A tiny notice was placed very recently in The Fernandina Beach News Leader, but the language was totally meaningless to most people, and if it had not been for the eagle eye of an attorney living amongst us, would have passed unnoticed. Surely there is a moral, if not legal, responsibility, to inform ALL parties likely to be affected, directly and in a manner they will understand and be able to respond to? One can only deduce that it was not the intention to provide opportunity for response!

I have also been informed that the proposed pump system is inefficient, prone to frequent breakdown and repair, and costly to run. Our present septic systems are efficient and cost effective. Unless financial help and incentives are offered, we are unlikely to be able to afford, or be willing, to replace them with the proposed alternative.

Dear Director,

I do hereby object to the application of United Water Florida, Inc. to extend their service area located in Nassau County, Florida as set forth in the legal notice on page 6C of the Fernandina Beach Newsleader dated 8/30/2000, on the following grounds:

1. The area sought in the extension is too broad.
2. The area sought in the extension is low density. There is no demand yet for this service.
3. If granted, this service will contribute to "urban sprawl" which is a violation of our Comprehensive Plan.
4. This service is being sought to accommodate one developer and if granted may, now or in the future, create incredible financial hardships for every man, woman and child in my community.
5. No information has been given to the public or the residents in the area affected as to the cost, the benefits, the timetable or any other details. I have spent the last 30 days trying to access the above information for my community and I have been given conflicting information from our county coordinator, county planner, county engineer, Health Department, county commissioners, and United Water Florida. I do not know who or what to believe.
