I am writing to respond to your letter dated September 29, 2000, to Blanca Bayó concerning the above-referenced order.

I presume that you are writing on behalf of Florida Power & Light Company, since that is the entity you usually represent before the Commission. Florida Power & Light Company is not a party to Docket No. 001048-EQ. No protest to Order No. PSC-00-1596-TRF-00 was filed, as the proposed action became final by Order No. PSC-00-1808-CO-EQ, issued October 3, 2000.

I believe the Order makes it clear that approval of this arrangement is on an experimental basis pursuant to Section 366.075, F.S. As with any Order of the Commission, the extent that it may be precedent for some future self-service wheeling arranged proposal will be dependent upon the facts and circumstances presented by that future proposal.
