Dear Mr. Peacock:

A docket has been opened by the Florida Public Service Commission to address the nonpayment of the Regulatory Assessment Fees (RAFs) required by Section 364.336, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-4.0161, Florida Administrative Code, for the year 1999, which was due January 30, 2000. Delinquent notices were mailed February 29, 2000, and to date, Commission records show that payment has not been received. In addition, the Commission has received returned mail for your company and this issue will also be addressed in this docket.

It is staff's intention to file a recommendation outlining the following two options: a \$1,000 fine for a first-time rule violation (\$500 per rule violation), or cancellation of your telecommunications certificate. The Commissioners will consider staff's recommendation at the January 2, 2001 Agenda Conference. A Proposed Agency Action Order will then be issued within 20 days after the vote and your company will have 21 days after the issuance of the Order, to protest the Order. It should be noted that just paying the delinquent RAFs amount will not stop your certificate from being canceled.

If the Order is not protested and the past due amount is not paid in full, including statutory penalty and interest charges, your certificate will be canceled and the past due amount will be turned over to the Florida Comptroller's Office for collection. Therefore, it is important that you contact staff as soon as possible, but no later than November 14, 2000, to discuss your options.
